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Dear Reader,

The Second transnational meeting of “Click me, if you forgot (REMEM)”, has been realized on 21th and 22nd October, 2021 in Naples, ITALY, hosted by project partner COSVITEC. This was the first face to face event, after a setback caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the second meeting, partners analyzed the completed and ongoing activities for the project in the almost 2 years of implementation.

REMEM project is supported by Turkish National Agency under Erasmus+ Key Action 2 "Cooperation for Innovation and the Exchange of Good Practices / Strategic Partnerships in the Field of Adult Education".

Pamukkale University is the project coordinator, and the institutions Kırklareli University and Denizli Innovation Association (DİDER) from Turkey, COSVITEC Societa Consortile Arl from Italy, and Technical University of Cluj Napoca from Romania are the project partners.

Project Outputs Status:

01- Compilation and reporting of existing mobile applications – Completed in each Partner Country

02 - Mobile application development – Draft design has been completed and analyzed during online meetings. A measurement tool has been developed to assess the extent to which all functions involved in the mobile application were useful and a pilot testing has been conducted by all partners and affiliated entities with suggestions and corrections to be done. The results of the pilot application and the feedback received from the users were evaluated separately for each country, contributing to the necessary arrangements to be done to correct the application.

04 - Preparation of information book for relatives - A presentation including review and discussion of book chapters for 04 and evaluation of survey results and completed chapters has been presented by Prof Şahin Kapıkıran. All of the sections were reviewed one by one, and which arrangements should be made according to the purpose and scope of the project were discussed by all partners. Moreover, the completed questionnaires about the book chapters have been evaluated and the results of the surveys completed for 04 were presented for each Country, showing the differences and similarities between the national results.

During the 2-year project, other partners were informed about the dissemination activities and meetings held by our partners. The general interest of the project and the efficiency of the dissemination activities were evaluated.

During the meeting we also discussed about REMEM dissemination, quality plan, and sustainability plan. In the dissemination studies of the project, in addition to the project multiplier events, all partners agreed to hold at least 1 secondary school/high school and at least 1 corporate meeting.





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It was also decided to participate in ICETAS2022 with oral presentations. A special REMEM session is planned at NICE2022. In addition, an illustrated product about Alzheimer's disease, in the form of a children's book, will be included in the project outputs.
