4th Transnational meeting of “Click me, if you forgot (REMEm)”, has been realized on 23rd and 24th of June, 2022 in Baia Mare, ROMANIA, hosted by project partner Technical University Cluj-Napoca.

All partners participated in the meeting: Arzum İŞİTAN and Sahin KAPIKIRAN from Pamukkale University, Saban VAROL and Volkan GESUR from DIDER, Aniello GERVASIO from COSVITEC; Evren ÇAĞLARER, Gülcan İNER and Fırat ÖZCAN from KLU and Gratiela Dana BOCA from U.T.Cluj Napoca.

During the fourth meeting, partners analyzed the completed and ongoing activities for the project taking in consideration the end of implementation project. The meeting details and decisions taken at the meeting are as follows:

Arzum İŞİTAN (PAU) as manager coordinator present the 17th Chapters of book for relatives and confirm that in September an ISBN will be take for book, after final review. In function of the feedback an English version will be possible.

Ayşe CADIR from DIDER makes a presentation of the cover book for relatives and also the cover book for kids. In the mean time all partners will verify once again the translation in their language.



The platform was improving in function of partner's mentions from 3rd transnational meeting hosted by Kırklareli University. Also the quality of games section was improving especially the noise.

It was also decided to participate with articles in ICETAS 2022 which will be held in Tirana Albania between 19-23 October 2022 with special section for REMEM oral presentations and disseminate the project results.

A special REMEM session is planned at NICE 2022 which will be held in Baia Mare, Romania, between 16-17 of September 2022. We establish the topic for invited key note speaker: Arzum İŞİTAN (PAU), Evren ÇAĞLARER (KLU) and Sahin KAPIKIRAN (PAU) and their contribution for international conference.

In addition, Evren ÇAĞLARER (KLU), will be prepare the O3 part - Preparation of mobile application user guide, partners mention that it is necessary to give all information's taking in consideration of target project elderly people and their knowledge's in the field in function of survey results and phone mobile application used by relatives and patience.

A presentation made by Gratiela BOCA from UT Cluj Napocawhich present " A Cross Section model "using the data base results of project and make a comparison between countries and establish a SWOT Analyze of project results, as a conclusion Arzum İŞİTAN propose to continue the project with another application for teachers from high-school and general school. All partners including DIDER presented by Saban VAROL and Volkan GESUR was agree.

Because the project it is on the last month's and end of project it is near, Arzum İŞİTAN as a manager coordinator remember again the necessity of documents, and costs of project for each partners, she put accent on output and format report, and final results. She also put in evidence the good cooperation between partners even the pandemic time affect the project draft.

The last meeting will be held in Denizli, Turkey in November 16-17 , 2022 as a workshop which will be held in Denizli, Turkey at Pamukkale University.

We establish the Panels for 2 days, in first day open special presentation of project made by partners Italy, Romania and Turkey. Final workshop will present the results of the project to stakeholders such as associations, enterprises policy makers, and entrepreneurs in order to transfer the use of the mobile application and information book.. For the second day a brainstorming activities between students audience and invited specialists will be held.

After the final conclusion we made a Maramures Tour for half day and identify the special centers for regeneration and health for elderly peoples from Baia Sprie and Sighetul Marmatiei as a final result of project, and create a bridge between theoretical and practical activities in the field.
